Save a lot of time and have your loved ones contacted quickly. Under ICE list your emergency contact. Paramedics know what ICE means and they look for it immediately. ICE your cell phone NOW!

WATER CONSERVATION

This is a reminder from the Sacramento County Water Agency. Residential and commercial locations bearing a street address ending in an **odd number** are permitted to water only on **Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday**, and locations bearing a street address ending in an **even number** are permitted to water only on **Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday**. No watering is permitted on Mondays.

PROTECT OUR CHILDREN

School is in session and we still have a problem with speeders. Please **do not** speed as we have many children who walk to the bus stop, play in our streets and ride bicycles. Saving a few seconds does not compare to the safety and life of a child.

SAFETY TIPS FOR TRICK OR TREATING
