## HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS

- Wear bright or reflective clothing when walking, jogging or riding bicycles at night.
- Avoid the holiday rush – shop early and during the day!
- Watch for persons following you on foot or by car.
- Remember to make your home secure and appear lived in.
- Don't place purchases in your trunk and then leave to purchase more. Move your car. There are criminals watching and can get into trunks quickly and easily.
- Use the buddy system – shop with a friend.
- Never leave valuables in plain sight – CDs, purses, telephone, gifts, wallets, etc.
- Drive extra carefully and slowly when weather changes.
- Don't forget to turn on lights when you have wipers on.

- Keep your purse in front of you, not hanging on your shoulder.
- Keep money, debit/credit cards out of view before their use.
- Watch for suspicious persons lurking around the cash register. Look to see if anyone has any strange device that may be copying your number.
- Watch for suspicious acting person in the parking lot before you empty your cart.
- Watch for suspicious acting persons before and after you pump gas.
- Keep your receipt or any copies of paper that may have your account number.
- Watch for unknown or suspicion persons hanging around your home before you open your garage or get out of the car.
- Always lock doors, windows and turn on your alarm every time you leave.

- Look out for your neighbors and strangers lurking around their homes.

**Don't become complacent. You may not notice criminals, but they are always watching you.**
