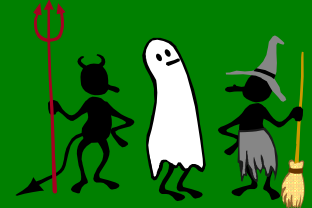
NEXTDOOR.COM

SAFETY TIPS FOR TRICK OR TREATING

1. Wear reflective or light colored costumes.
2. Take a flashlight or small light.
3. Go in groups.
4. Don't eat candy until it is inspected.
5. Always be aware of your surroundings.
6. Look before you cross streets!
7. Homes with no lights on are not participating in trick or treat. Do not disturb them. Watch your step as it may be very dark around these homes.



ICE

ICE stands for "In Case of Emergency". If you add an entry in the contacts list in your cell phone under ICE, emergency services will know who to call. Save a lot of time and have your loved ones contacted quickly. Under ICE list your emergency contact. Paramedics know what ICE means and they look for it immediately. ICE your cell phone NOW!

HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS

- For Online, purchases have tem picked up ASAP or ask they are placed in arear not visible to the street.
- At night, wear bright or reflective clothing when walking, jogging or riding bicycles (helmet always).
- Avoid the holiday rush – shop early and during the day! Or go with a friend at night.
- Use a purse that can be secured to your body.
- Make your home secure and appear lived in.
- Don't place purchases in your trunk and leave to purchase more. Move your car. There are criminals watching and can get into trunks quickly and easily.

- Do not leave valuables visible in your car.
- Be Aware of Surroundings. Do not be distracted by your telephone or earphones. You become a target.
