#### **CRIME PREVENTION TIPS**

#### DO NOT BECOME COMPLACENT

- Always be aware of your surroundings-even at home and shopping! Watch for suspicious acting people.
- Identify theft continues to be a threat. Do not leave bills overnight in mailbox. Shred any personal information.
- Pick up packages as soon as possible.

- Watch for anyone following you home or waiting on your street.
- To prevent Car theft and vandalism, always secure your vehicle doors, windows, hood and trunk. Secure your catalytic converters.
- Put <u>all</u> packages and valuables out of sight including telephones and garage door opener.
- Never wear extravagant jewelry when going out alone. Still be vigilant when with other people.
- Don't give out personal information to callers. There is a scam whereby a caller will say that she is representing or knows a relative who needs money. Hang up and call your relative. These callers usually have a very sad story; then ask for money.
- Don't let your kindness influence your common sense.
- Lock both your car and inside garage door. Keep garage door closed.
- If you must park outside your garage, an alarm helps to scare thieves.
- Pay attention to all alarms.
- Purchase a camera if possible.

- Keep your purse close to your body or use your pockets.
- Never attach a tag with your name and address to a key ring.
- Don't open door to strangers and teach your children not to open any door to strangers whether children or adults.
