CRIME PREVENTION TIPS

DO NOT BECOME COMPLACENT

- Always be aware of your surroundings-even at home and shopping! Watch for suspicious acting people.
- Identify theft continues to be a threat. Do not leave bills overnight in mailbox. Shred any personal, financial information.
- Watch for anyone following you home. It happens.
- Always secure your vehicle doors, windows, hood and trunk to prevent car theft.
- Put all packages and valuables out of sight

including telephones and garage door opener.

- Never wear extravagant jewelry when going out alone.
- Lock both your car and inside garage door. Keep garage door closed.
- If you must park outside your garage, an alarm helps to scare thieves.
- Pay attention to all alarms.
- Keep your purse close to your body or use your pockets.
- Never attach a tag with your name and address to a key ring.
- Teach your children not to open any door to strangers or give out personal information to unknown persons, websites or cell phones.
